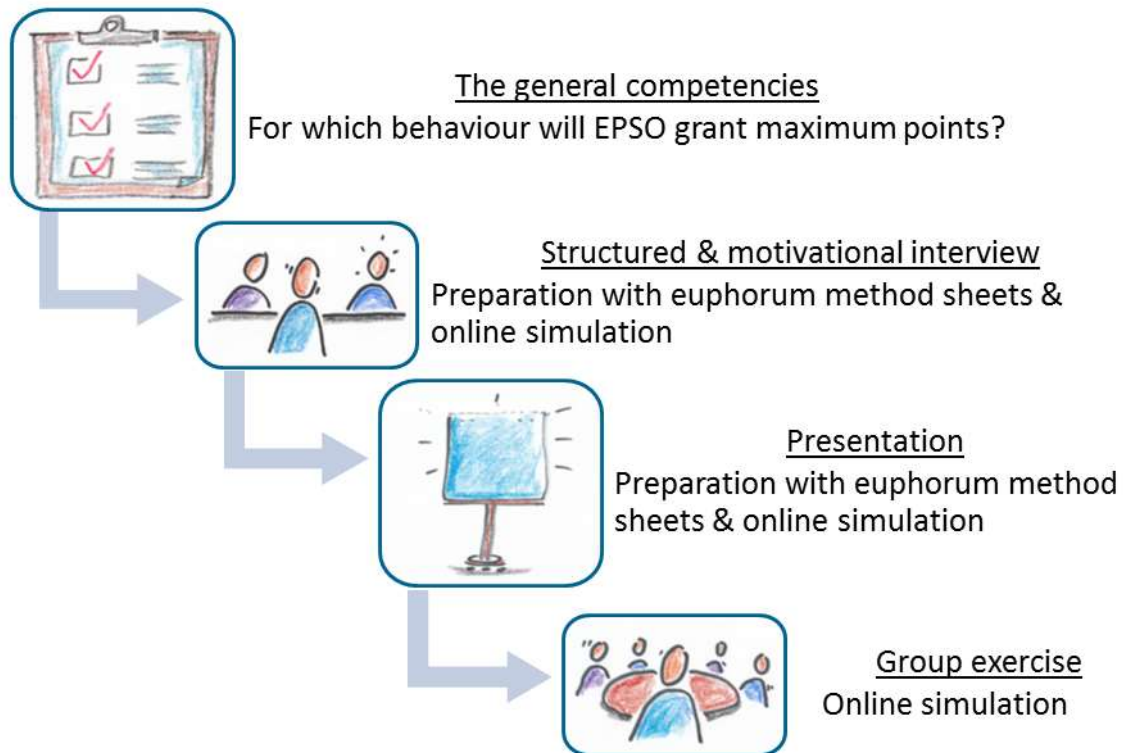


EPSO Assessment Centre online preparation

Objectives

- Optimal preparation on EPSO Assessment Centre of EPSO/AD/356+357/18
- Detailed knowledge on all selections instruments
- Convincing presentation of own abilities



Content

- The EPSO competency framework
- The structured interview– identification of suitable professional situations and experiences, presentation of own competencies
- The presentation – online simulation of a case, reflection of presentation discussion and the use of flipchart
- Group exercise– online simulation of a case, reflection of behaviour and individual feedback

The EPSO competency framework

We work with you to find out how the eight tested general competences analysis and problem solving, communication, quality and result orientation, personal and professional development, prioritising and organising, resilience, teamwork and leadership can be put into practice and which behaviour is well assessed by EPSO during the assessment Centre to receive a high score.

Structured interview

First, you identify professional experiences, with which the competences can be explained and illustrated. We advise you in the identification of suitable examples. In an online meeting we then simulate the structured interview. We repeat the interview with you to make sure that you can convincingly present your competences.

The motivational interview

You will study our booklet: "The motivational interview". Then, we carry out an interactive online simulation. You will receive specific information in order to achieve a high score in the interview.

Group exercise

You will study our booklet: "The group exercise". Then, we carry out an interactive online simulation with six participants. You receive a case and the group has to find a solution. We will assess your interventions and provide an individual feedback. You receive concrete advices, how to achieve many points. In case there will be not six candidates participating in the group exercise, we will intensively work with you on how the tested general competencies can be realised.

The presentation

You will study our booklet: "The presentation". Then, we carry out an interactive online simulation. You can deliver the presentation in English or German. And you receive feedback on presentation, the discussion and the use of the flipchart.
