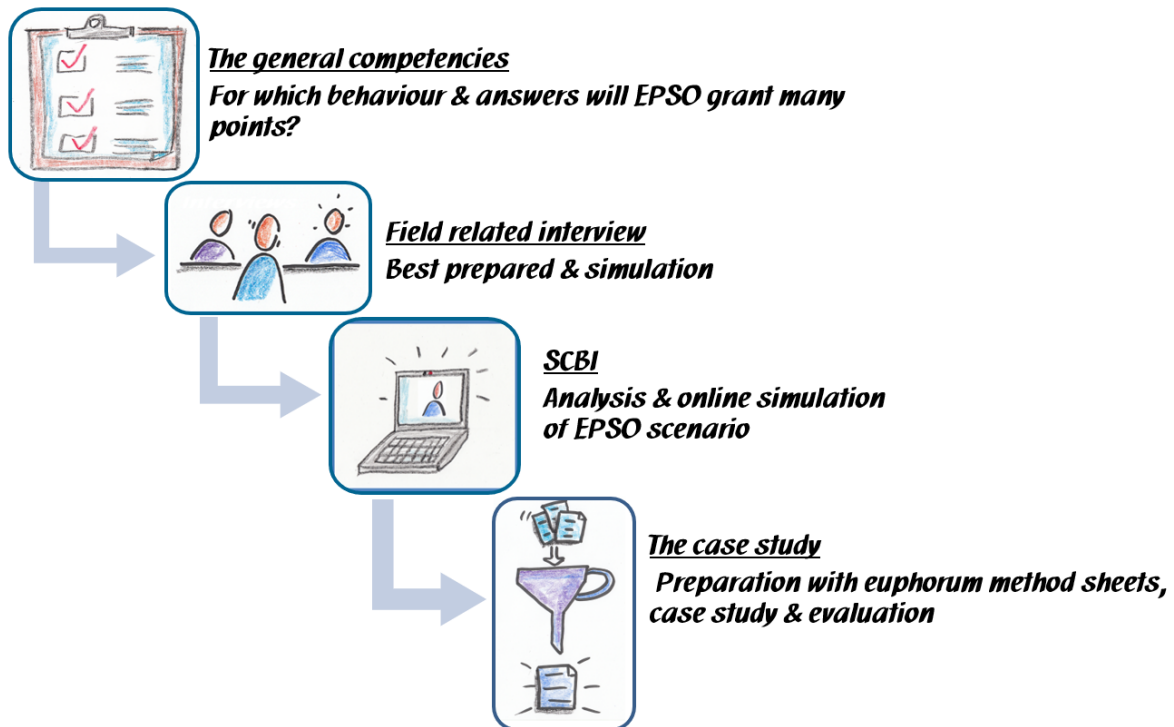

The EPSO competency framework

We work with you to find out how the eight tested general competences analysis and problem solving, (written) communication, quality and result orientation, personal and professional development, prioritising and organising, resilience, working with others and leadership can be put into practice and which behaviour is well assessed by EPSO during the assessment Centre to receive a high score.

The field related interview

You will study our euphorum learning booklet: "The field related interview (FRI) " beforehand. We clarify with you the areas that this interview can cover and show you how candidates were tested in previous exercises. Then we simulate the meeting and give you individual feedback afterwards.

SCBI

You will study our booklet: "The SCBI" and the original EPSO scenario. We will analyse with you the EPSO case and carry out an interactive online simulation. We will assess your interventions and provide individual feedback. You receive concrete advice, how to achieve many points.

The case study

You will study our booklet: "The case study". We will develop with you how a very strong text should look like. You exercise one case, we assess your text. You receive concrete advice, how to achieve many points.
